### Williamsburg Brewery Environmental Overview

---

The Williamsburg brewery brews more than 9 million barrels of beer per year. The brewery is part of the Anheuser-Busch complex in Williamsburg, which also includes Kingsmill Resort & Spa, Busch Gardens Europe and Water Country USA.

**Helping the Environment** The Williamsburg brewery recycled more than 99 percent of the solid waste it generated in 2006.

The brewery recycled more than 2 billion pounds of materials, including recovered alcohol, beechwood chips, grains from the brewing process and wooden pallets.

#### **Energy Savings**

The brewery assembled a Water and Energy Conservation Task Force to manage its energy and water reduction projects, as well as conservation ideas suggested by employees. This year, the brewery also held an Energy Conservation Fair for employees with information on saving energy at home, recycling and environmental stewardship.

#### **Water Savings**

The Williamsburg brewery recently installed automated controls to eliminate chilled water overflow from the packaging process. This process improvement change saved 17 million gallons of water in 2006.
